

August 2nd - Primary

Deadline to Register to Vote for the August Election is July 5, 2016

November 8th - General

Two City Council positions will be on the November 8th Ballot.

Nominating Petition Deadline for City Council positions is August 16, 2016 @ 4:00 p.m.

Absentee Ballot - If you are 60 years or older you qualify to be on the **Permanent Absent Voter List**. When on this list, you will automatically receive an absent voter **application** for every election. If you choose to return that application, we will send you a ballot as soon as they arrive in our office. No phone calls, no time crunch, no lines, no hassle.

TIME FOR CHANGE/UPGRADE

- **Software Change** - We are going to have complete software conversion during month of June & July for Utility Billing, Accounts Payable and other internal programs, with the addition of a Cemetery software. Also the availability to accept credit/debit cards.
- **Comprehensive Plan** - includes plans for the Parks & Recreation, Downtown Development, Industrial Park Development, Master Zoning and Neighborhood Preservation. These plans are being updated/created to make the City eligible for future grants for improvements of the City. This project should be completed by January 2017.

TRASH GENERAL INFORMATION

You are allowed 8-10 bags per week. Garbage needs to be bagged when using containers larger than 30 gallons. Weight limit on containers is 40 pounds.

Garbage **MUST** be out by 7am Monday. If it is not out it will not be picked up until the next week.



YARD WASTE INFORMATION

Yard waste pick up will be once per week on Monday. Yard waste **MUST** be curbside by 7am. Grass and plant clippings will be collected from 30 gallon or smaller containers with a weight limit of 40 pounds. Containers must be marked with an "X". Branches must be no longer than 4ft. and tied into Bundles.
